FINDINGS OF FACT

- 2. On August 25, 1992, the Commission issued a notice to the parties setting a telephone scheduling conference in these matters for September 30, 1992, at 9:15 a.m.

- 4. On October 15, 1992, the Commission held a telephone scheduling conference at which petitioner was not able to be reached.
- 5. On October 15, 1992, the Commission issued a SCHEDULING ORDER resetting the telephone scheduling conference to November 5, 1992, at 10:15 a.m., and ordering that 'Failure to appear may result in dismissal of the appeal.'
- 6. On November 5, 1992, the Commission held a telephone scheduling conference at which petitioner was not able to be reached.
- 7. The petitioner has failed to appear at the telephone scheduling conferences and prosecute his petitions for review on file with the Commission.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED

That the petitions for review herein are dismissed.
